Re: Historic Trust requests Immediate Release of the Heritage By-law

Dear Mayor Breen, Deputy Mayor O'Leary, and Councillors Burton, Collins, Froude, Hanlon, Hickman, Jamieson, Korab, Lane, and Stapleton:

The City of St. John's has requested comments from the public on the Envision St. John's Draft Development Regulations. The Draft Development Regulations no longer contains the Heritage Area Standards (currently found in the existing Development Regulations). The Draft Development Regulations are silent on what is permitted within municipally designated heritage areas.

The Newfoundland and Labrador Historic Trust calls upon the City of St. John's to release the draft Heritage By-law to the public immediately. Members of the heritage preservation community, and the Historic Trust specifically, cannot evaluate the sufficiency of the draft Development Regulations without reviewing the Heritage By-Law.
